1 Complete TB Questionnaire

2 Send Transcripts

We will need an official high school transcript sent directly to us from your high school.

If you are a transfer student, or have college credit from another institution, we will also need final, official transcripts from each college you have attended. Financial Aid will not be awarded until all transcripts are received.

Note: We cannot accept hand-delivered, emailed, or faxed transcripts as official. Transcripts must include final grades, cumulative GPA and a graduation date.

3 Send ACT scores or take assessment test

If you took the ACT, send your scores to admission@gcccks.edu. If you did not take the ACT, you will be required to take our complimentary Accuplacer placement assessment prior to enrollment. For questions or to set up an appointment contact the assessment center at 620-276-9654.

Note: If you are a transfer student and have already started your Math or English sequence, you can enroll based on your previous college coursework

4 Complete the housing application

Annual Room & Meal Plan (Includes 19 meals per week)

West and East Units \$5,930

The West Hall is comprised of long hallways with two-person bedrooms and large restrooms down the hall. Each room includes extra-long twin beds, closets, desks, chairs, drawers and bookshelves.

Located along the east side of the Residential Life courtyard, the East Units comprise of four two-person bedrooms, a large restroom and common area with a limited cooking area. Each room includes extra-long twin beds, closets, desks, chairs, shelves and drawers.

Broncbuster Housing \$6,630

Located on the south side of Spruce Street across from the main campus the Broncbuster Houses consist of four bedrooms, two restrooms, furnished living room, furnished dining area, limited cooking area, lockable storage room and two linen-closets in the hallway.

Each room includes extra-long twin beds, closets, desks, chairs, and three-drawer dressers.

Apartments \$7,130

Located along the west and south side of the Residential Life courtyard the Apartments comprise of three bedrooms, two restrooms, furnished living room (loveseat, chair, coffee table and end table), and fully equipped kitchen (stove, refrigerator, table and chairs). Each room includes extra-long twin beds, closets, desks, chairs, and three-drawer dressers.

Broncbuster Suites \$7,330

The Broncbuster Suites provide a fully furnished kitchen including stove, full size refrigerator, garbage disposal and dishwasher. Each suite has a furnished living room, restroom and its own washer and dryer! Each room includes extra-long twin beds, closet, 3-drawer dresser and wardrobe. The suites are located one block south of Spruce Street and the main campus.

Tuition & Fees Fall & Spring

All annual figures are based on a 15-credit-hour per semester load for a full-time student. Minimum graduation requirements equal 60 credit hours for associate's degree. Costs are subject to change.

- Kansas Resident \$112 per credit hours x 30 credit hours = \$3,360
- Border State (CO, MO, NE, NM, OK, TX) \$126 per credit hours x 30 credit hours = \$3,780
- Out-of-State \$131 per credit hours x 30 credit hours = \$3,930
- International \$149 per credit hours x 30 credit hours = \$4,470
